**VILLAGE OF OLIVER
EROSION CONTROL PERMIT APPLICATION
CHAPTER 140 OF THE OLIVER MUNICIPAL CODE**

No landowner or land user may commence a land disturbance or land development activity subject to this ordinance without receiving prior approval of an erosion control plan for the site and a permit from the local approval authority. For erosion control activities required in Section 8 of the Village Municipal Code, applicants shall submit this application along with a control plan and pay an application fee to the Village. Within 30 days of receipt of the application, control plan statement, and fee, the local approval authority will review same to determine if all requirements of the ordinance are met.

ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION MUST BE PROVIDED ON THIS FORM.

INCLUDE FEE OF \$50.00 PLUS EROSION CONTROL PLOT PLAN.

Section 8. Content of the Erosion Control Plan for Land Development and Land Disturbing Activities Covering Less Than One Acre

A. An erosion control plan/statement (with a simple map) shall be submitted to briefly describe:

1. Property boundaries and area to be disturbed
2. Lakes, streams, wetlands, channels, ditches and other watercourses on and within 500 feet of the site
3. Direction of slopes before and after development
4. Existing and proposed buildings and other improvements
5. Size of up-slope drainage areas
6. Development schedule
7. Best Management practices necessary to meet the requirements of this article
8. Description of vegetation and other materials to be used to stabilize the site including a schedule of installation and maintenance
9. Name, address and daytime telephone number of the applicant and the person responsible for maintenance of best management practices.
